2008 AUTOVANTAGE ROAD RAGE SURVEY

BOSTON

- **SECOND LEAST COURTEOUS**—Boston ranked as the second least courteous city in terms of road rage, compared to 24 other major American cities. Last year, Boston ranked as the third least courteous city. Miami was ranked as the worst city for the third year in a row. The top 10 worst cities of 2008 are:

- Pittsburgh ranked as the most courteous city.
- **REAR ENDING**—Boston drivers ranked No. 1 for the second consecutive year for slamming into the back of a bad driver's vehicle as a reaction to rude or aggressive behavior. Three percent of those surveyed admitted committing this offense within the last month.
- **HORN HONKING**—Motorists in Boston ranked No. 3 in terms of honking as a reaction to bad drivers. Fifty percent of people surveyed in Boston admitted to doing this within the last month. Boston tied for third place with Houston and Miami.
