## IN THE DRIVER'S SEAT

### 2008 AUTOVANTAGE ROAD RAGE SURVEY

### BALTIMORE

- **FOURTH LEAST COURTEOUS**—Baltimore ranked as the fourth least courteous city in terms of road rage, compared to 24 other major American cities. Last year, Baltimore was the 11<sup>th</sup> most courteous city. Miami was the worst city for road rage for the third consecutive year. The top 10 worst cities of 2008 are:

- Pittsburgh ranked as the most courteous city.
- **EATING AND DRINKING**—At 57 percent, drivers in Baltimore tied with Tampa and New York for being the most likely to observe other drivers eating or drinking while driving. Pittsburgh is least likely to do this, at 36 percent.
- **SPEEDING**—Drivers in Baltimore ranked No. 3 in terms of admitting they drive too fast on a daily basis (16 percent). Atlanta ranked No. 1 with 22 percent. Detroit motorists are least likely to admit speeding (7 percent).
- **CELL PHONE USE**—Baltimore ranked No. 4 for cell phone use as 27 percent admitted to talking while driving every day. Atlanta ranked No. 1. Only 12 percent of drivers in Philadelphia admit to using their cell phone while driving daily.
