IN THE DRIVER'S SEAT

2008 AUTOVANTAGE ROAD RAGE SURVEY

TAMPA

- **NINTH LEAST COURTEOUS** – Tampa tied Dallas/Ft. Worth as the ninth least courteous city in terms of road rage, compared to 24 other major American cities. Miami was ranked the worst for the third consecutive year. The top 10 worst cities are:

#1	Miami	#6	Atlanta
#2	Boston	#7	Los Angeles
#3	New York	#8	Phoenix
#4	Baltimore	#9	Dallas (tie)
#5	Washington, D.C.	#9	Tampa (tie)

- Pittsburgh was ranked as the most courteous city.
- **EATING AND DRINKING** – At 57 percent, drivers in Tampa are tied with Baltimore and New York for being the most likely to observe other drivers eating or drinking while driving every day. Pittsburgh is least likely to do this, at 36 percent.
- **MULTI-TASKING** – Drivers in Tampa are most likely to observe other drivers multi-tasking (like putting on makeup, shaving or reading) while driving every day, at 40 percent; Tampa was ranked eighth last year.
- **RUNNING RED LIGHTS** – Tampa drivers are the second most likely to observe other drivers running red lights, at 47 percent. Cleveland is least likely to observe this, at 10 percent.
